Prerogative Court of Canterbury Wills

All PCC Wills held by the Public Record Office (grouped in the series PROB 11), which are available on Documents Online, cover the period from 1384 to 1858. Until that date, all wills had to be proved (formally approved) by church and other courts. The Prerogative Court of Canterbury, the most important of these courts, dealt with the relatively wealthy individuals living mainly in the south of England and most of Wales (what was originally the ecclesiastical province of Canterbury).

Notes from early Wills and Other documents

Joan Eacott 1619 - Rendcombe : Buried in Rendcomb churchyard.

Brothers - Will Eacott, Richard Eacott, Thomas Eacott.

Sisters - Susan Chamberlain, Margaret Broade. Also Thomas son of Richard Eacott. Susan Jefferies her mother-in-law.

Thomas Eycott 1740 - North Cerney: Catholic, a bachelor. to William Eycott of Cirencester his nephew and only next of kin. His sister Rebecca and Martha freehold estate at Woodmancote and have cottage there until married.

John Eycott 1751 - Cirencester: catholic, a goldsmith of Cirencester. Estate at Bagendon, mother Mary, wife Elizabeth, sons Richard and John, freehold estate at Chedworth payment to sisters.

William Eacott 1760 - Tetbury: Charleton in Tetbury parish.
Daughter Elizabeth wife of Jonathan Avery. Son Richard Eacott.

William Ecutt 1776 - Cromhall: Sons John eldest, William, Robert, Philip. John inherited
Messuage and tenement. Also owned two other cottages. He was remarried.
