

# Indicators of Learning Skills

## Organization

The student:

- uses a planning process;
- brings the required materials to class;
- shows organization in his/her notebook;
- uses appropriate resources.

## Work Habits

The student:

- completes class work and homework;
- works with attention to detail;
- shows thought and revision in written work;
- reviews and studies appropriately;
- follows instructions of assigned work;
- uses class time effectively and submits work on time.

## Teamwork

The student:

- listens actively;
- shows respect for all group members;
- completes the appropriate portion of the group's work;
- co-operates to complete the task;
- uses conflict-management skills;
- adopts a variety of roles in group-work settings;
- works constructively towards group goals and shares ideas

## Initiative

The student

- actively and constructively participates in class discussions;
- takes responsibility for his/her own learning;
- demonstrates classroom leadership;
- acts to solve problems;
- tries new techniques or approaches to learning;
- reflects on his/her own progress and adapts strategies;
- shows interest in new learning.

## Works Independently

The student:

- demonstrates commitment to the task;
- uses a variety of problem-solving strategies;
- accepts responsibility for his/her own behaviour;
- plans and executes tasks with minimal teacher assistance.
