What you must have.....

Course Tools

- ⇒ 3 ring binder with paper
- ⇒ scientific calculator (you will need the exponent, square root, brackets, etc. buttons)
- ⇒ pencil, blue or black pen, red pen, eraser, ruler, protractor, etc.
- ⇒ graph paper

What you must bring to class every day

- ⇒ your textbook
- ⇒ all course tools

Notebook Requirements

- ⇒ you MUST keep your notes in a 3 ring binder (you will be given many handouts throughout the semester)
- ⇒ your notebook must include an up-to-date and neat table of contents (see handout)
- ⇒ the table of contents need only be used to keep your notes in order, homework and tests need not be included
- ⇒ each note in your notebook must contain a page number, date and title
- ⇒ all notes should be written neatly, a blue or black pen is recommended
- ⇒ all titles and dates should be underlined with a red pen
- ⇒ all lines should be drawn with a ruler
- ⇒ all notes should be in the front of your notebook
- ⇒ all homework should be kept in the back of your notebook
- ⇒ all homework, tests, quizzes and assignments should be written in pencil
- ⇒ all tests, quizzes, assignments should be kept in the back of your notebook after they have been returned to you
- ⇒ all tests and quizzes must be signed by your parents

Notebook Order

1. Table of Contents
2. Notes
3. Homework
4. Test, etc.

Note:

It is the responsibility of each student to catch up on missed work. If a student knows he/she will be away for a test, or if a test is missed for unforeseen reasons, the student will be expected to write the test in the Math Help room at lunch time or at a mutually agreed upon time.
